May 28-30th - Happy Birthday, Mr. President

We celebrate the 100th birthday of John F. Kennedy with a visit to two places he held dear - Cape Cod and Boston. Our three day tour will bring back some great memories while embracing the changes to Boston and Cape Cod. Accommodations will be at the Resort and Conference Center at Hyannis. The itinerary includes the JFK Memorial, The JFK Museum, Hyannis Harbor Cruise, the Cape Cod Seashore, John F. Kennedy Library, and the Quincy Market. Two breakfasts and two dinners are included.

June 14th - Sunset Boulevard (starring Glenn Close)

Glenn Close revisits her Tony Award-winning performance of Norma Desmond in this acclaimed revival. Impoverished screen writer, Joe Gillis, on the run from debt collectors, stumbles into her reclusive world. Persuaded to work on Norma's 'masterpiece', a film script that she believes will put her back in front of the cameras, he is seduced by her and her luxurious life-style. Joe becomes entrapped in a claustrophobic world until his love for another woman leads him to try and break free with dramatic consequences. Luncheon on Times Square is included.

June 29th - A Day at High Point

Nestled in the scenic Skylands between the Poconos and the Catskills, the High Point Country Club will bring you back to an era where comfort and luxury were the norm. The day consists of a full buffet breakfast, early dinner, four hour open bar, two shows (impersonator/singer/comedian Eric Kearns is the headliner), casino hour (bingo and horse racing for dollars), nature trails along the private lake, bocce, corn hole, and miniature golf). July 12th - Chihuly at the New York Botanical Gardens (Limited to 35 people!)

For the first time in ten years the glass sculpture of world-renowned sculptor Dale Chihuly will be featured in a major exhibition in New York. Monumental installations will be located throughout notable locations at the New York Botanical Gardens. No need to worry about too much walking. The narrated tram tour is included. Lunch is at Ann & Tony's on Arthur Avenue. Discover a traditional Arthur Avenue experience thousands of people like you have been getting from this family owned Arthur Avenue restaurant since 1927. After lunch we head to Yonkers and board the Science Barge - a sustainable urban farm on a floating barge. Our guide will show us how they produce their own energy through solar and wind turbines, grow food through aquaponics systems and other sustainable methods. It is truly an amazing place.

July 22nd - Trains & Treasures - Pennsylvania's Americana

All aboard the beautifully restored Colebrookdale Railroad as we discover the treasures of Southeastern PA aboard Edwardian-era coaches. A box lunch will be provided by the railroad. After our scenic ride we head to Pottstown for a ride on the Carousel at Pottstown. Built in 1905, the merry-go-round is the oldest wooden carousel in the United States. It took more than ten years to restore this work of art to its present state. We conclude our day at Renninger's Antiques & Farmer's Market in Kutztown where there are 200 booths full of art and vintage items, and forty local merchants selling local produce, snacks, crafts, jewelry and more.

August 11th - Lady Liberty Cruise and the Secret Garden

Take in unparalleled views of Manhattan's iconic skyline and landmarks including the Statue of Liberty, Ellis Island, Freedom Tower, the Brooklyn Bridge and more. The two hour cruise aboard the luxurious Hornblower Yacht includes a delicious buffet lunch. After our lunch cruise we head to Greenwich Village to the Church of St. Luke in the Fields Gardens. Considered one of the "secret gardens" of New York, you can stroll or sit and appreciate the beauty of the blooms and foliage. If time allows, grab a dessert at one of the West Village's great pastry or ice cream shops.

August 28-29th - Katharine Hepburn's Connecticut

This may be our best Summer overnight yet! Join us as our tour follows the Shoreline of Connecticut. Our home base is the magnificent Water's Edge Resort and Spa on the beach in Westbrook, CT. Originally built in 1901, and destroyed by a fire, this magnificent property began its restoration in 1981 and has continually expanded and upgraded. Our tour includes a luncheon cruise on the Connecticut River aboard the Lady Katherine, a tour of the Lockwood-Matthews Mansion, a tour of the Pez factory, a tour and tasting at Fascia's Chocolates, browsing at the shops of Yale, and maybe a slice of pizza at the famous Frank Pepe Pizzeria. Breakfast, dinner, and lunch cruise are included.

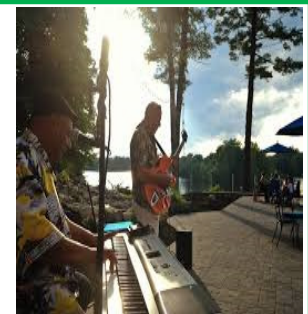
