### April 27 - Resorts Casino

The Thomaston Opera House, completed in 1885, and famous for its pipe organ, houses the show. A short pipe organ recital precedes the performance. Listed in the Guinness Book of Records as the longest running play in the history of the United States, the show brings its blend of madcap improvisation and spine-tickling mystery to New York. A luncheon in Times Square precedes the show.

### July 3 - "America Sings"

Celebrate the music of America with a high-energy, star-studded salute. Featuring fabulous dancing, beautiful singing, and a veritable hit parade of music that you know and love, "America Sings" (at the Pines Dinner Theatre in Allentown, PA) is the perfect way to start your Summer celebration. Show and luncheon are included.

#### July 19-20 - Connecticut Double Play

C'mon and take advantage of Winter rates in July. We head to both Foxwoods and Mohegan Sun Casinos for an overnight spree. Accommodations are at the Microtel in Uncasville (about 1.3 miles from Mohegan Sun). Two slot bonuses, and 2 buffets are included in the price.

### August 5 - The Forgotten Borough (Staten Island)

This tour is going to be a fun and eye-opening experience. We drive to Manhattan and take the Staten Island Ferry (Didn't you always want to do that?) Visitors can explore eight pavilions, a bamboo forest path, waterfalls, a Koi-filled pond, Chinese calligraphy, and a variety of Ghongshi scholar's rocks including a 15-foot formation that towers over the central courtyard at the Scholar's garden. It's Friday, so the Heritage farm stand grows and sells seasonally fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs, and flowers.

#### August 18-19 - Long Island's East End

A day is not enough to explore the North and South Forks of Long Island. We start with a luncheon cruise to the Fire Island Lighthouse aboard the Lauren Kristy paddle wheeler. After the cruise we head to the Hamptons for a tasting at the Duck Walk Vineyards. Our coach continues to Montauk where we have dinner at Gosman's Dock. Overnight accommodations are at the beautiful Inn at East Wind. Our second day includes a visit to a farm stand and a tour of the Long Island Museum of American Art, History, and Carriages in Stony Brook.


