<u>April 1, 2020</u> - Cherry Blossoms in Brooklyn (No Foolin')

This tour will be both nostalgic and eye-opening. Every year the Brooklyn Botanic Garden hosts its Cherry Blossom Festival. Several varieties of cherry blossoms are in bloom (not all at the same time). The Japanese Garden is one of the finest anywhere. In addition to the Botanic Garden we will enjoy a guided tour of some of the neighborhoods in Brooklyn. Luncheon is at the original Junior's Restaurant on Flatbush Avenue. Cheesecake is included!

April 25-26, 2020 - "Queen Esther" at the Sight & Sound Theatre

Experience one of the most riveting Bible stories of the Old Testament as it comes to life with magnificent sets, special effects and live animals in this brand-new, original stage production! QUEEN ESTHER is a captivating tale of beauty and bravery. Esther's ordinary life changed forever when she was taken through the palace doors, entering a new world of royalty and risk. This is the latest at Sight & Sound's Lancaster theatre. We have added two new attractions to complement the tour - Bryn Allyn Cathedral and Frank Lloyd Wright's Temple Beth Sholom. Overnight accommodations are at the Lancaster Arts Hotel.

May 27, 2020 - Wonderlands in New Jersey

Only a short drive to Flemington, New Jersey takes us to *Northlandz* - the world's largest miniature wonderland. This wonderland is culmination of 25 years of dedication to the arts and creativity. You will not believe your eyes as you casually stroll through acres of mountains, valleys, bridges, tunnels and more. The 94 room La Peep Dollhouse, and the Doll Museum with more than 200 dolls are included. After a luncheon at Al Fresco's we head to the *Ground s for Sculpture* - a 42-acre sculpture park, museum, and arboretum founded on the site of the former New Jersey State Fairgrounds. After our guided tour you can explore some of the six indoor sculpture galleries.

June 10, 2020 - Fire Island Lighthouse Tour

All aboard the Lauren Kristy paddle wheeler at the Bay Shore Marina for a four hour tour of the Great South Bay to include a visit to the Fire Island Lighthouse. Climb the 182 steps in the tower if you are adventurous. Lunch is served aboard the Lauren Kristy and dessert is served on the return from Fire Island. We complete the day with a visit to a popular Long Island farm stand.

June 21-22, 2020 - Mayflower 400 (Plymouth and Provincetown)

Walk in the footsteps of the Pilgrims as we celebrate the 400th anniversary of the landing of the Mayflower on the shores of coastal Massachusetts. We will visit Plimoth Plantation, go aboard the Mayflower II which will be returning from Mystic where it has been restored. In the quaint town of Provincetown we will visit the Pilgrim Monument and museum. Perhaps you will climb the 272 foot monument which has been a tradition for a hundred years. After a break downtown we will board our vehicles for a dunes ride along the beaches of P-Town. Our hotel is in downtown Plymouth.

July 11-12, 2020 - Stephen Sondheim's 90th Birthday

Only 50 miles North of New York City the Carmaoor Center for Music and the Arts in Katonah pays tribute to Stephen Sondheim, Tony Award-winning composer and lyricist. Four Broadway stars will perform songs from Company, Follies, Sweeney Todd, Merrily We Roll Along, Anyone Can Whistle, and more. We will tour the Hammond Museum and Japanese Stroll Garden in New Salem and visit the town of Katonah prior to the performance. On the second day we will head to Dutchess County to visit the Trevor Zoo– a family-oriented small zoo run by the students of the Millbrook School. The 180 animals at the zoo are highlighted by eight endangered red pandas. We will have a tasting at Millbrook Vineyards prior to time in the town of Rhinebeck.

July 22, 2020 - "9to 5" at the Westchester Broadway Theatre

What a way to make a livin'. Sing along with Dolly Parton's music and lyrics as you enjoy this fun-filled hit based on the 1980 hit movie. Luncheon is served prior to the performance.

August 8, 2020 - "Dames at Sea" at the Bucks County Playhouse

In the tradition of 42nd Street, the tap-happy Dames at Sea is guaranteed to lift your spirits. This delightful musical comedy is set on a naval battleship after the cast discovers their theatre is going to be demolished. Lunch is at the Deck which is attached to the Bucks County Playhouse. After the show, enjoy some browsing time in New Hope.

August 23, 2020 - "Mrs. Doubtfire" on Broadway

Help is on the way, dear. From a sold-out, record-breaking run at Seattle's 5th Avenue Theatre , the hilarious and heart-warming musical comes to Broadway at the Stephen Sondheim Theatre. A special deli dinner at Gayle's Broadway Rose with singing servers follows the matinee performance.



Registration/Cancellation Policy
