June 7, 2021 - The Philadelphia Flower Show

The PHS Philadelphia Flower Show, the nation's largest and longest-running horticultural event, will move outdoors for the first time, making the 2021 Show a history-making experience that will incorporate the beautiful landscapes of FDR Park in Philadelphia. Our morning visit will end with a catered picnic in a reserved area of the park. There will be a visit to an iconic site in Philadelphia after lunch.

June 19, 2021 - Broadway Memories

Broadway may not be back until September but the great stories and memories remain. Broadway Up Close, winner of the Trip Advisor Award for Excellence, takes us on a walking tour through the Theatre District narrating stories and using a tablet to display memorable images. For an hour and forty-five minutes you'll hear those tales, from the flops and disasters to the successes and legends. We move to Gayle's Broadway Rose where the wait staff will sing some of your favorite Broadway tunes as they serve your deli lunch. Don't forget to sing along!

July 7, 2021 - Fire Island Lighthouse Cruise

All aboard the Lauren Kristy paddle wheeler, a 65 foot turn-of-the-century style riverboat. We sail from the Bay Shore Marina for a smooth luncheon cruise on the Great South Bay. A stop is made at the Fire Island Lighthouse where you can walk the boardwalk to the Lighthouse. A visit to a farmer's market follows the cruise.

July 21. 2021 - The Gilded Age in Connecticut

Hop aboard the Thames River Heritage Park Water Taxi where you'll visit a collection of national and historic sites along the Groton and New London shores of the Thames River that tell the stories that shaped our nation. August 21, 2021 – Bellini Brunch and Sheffield Island Lighthouse Tour
