October 16-17, 2021 - Fall Foliage in the Litchfield Hills (Connecticut)

Our brand new Fall Foliage Tour take us only two ours away to the Litchfield Hills of Connecticut - birthplace of Ethan Allen, and Harriet Beecher Stowe. All aboard the Naugatuck Railroad for a scenic tour of the Litchfield Hills and Naugatuck Valley. Lunch is at the Marketplace (converted old jail) in the quaint town of Litchfield. After lunch we head to the Haight-Brown Vineyard (first farm winery in Connecticut) for a tasting and chocolate pairing. Dinner is at Cugino's Restaurant in Farmington and overnight accommodations are at the boutique, colonial-style Farmington Inn. The second day is a totally different treat. After breakfast at the hotel we head down the road to the Hillstead Museum for a guided tour of the Pope Riddle House (home of Cleveland iron industrialist Alfred Atmore Pope) and gardens. The museum collection includes paintings by Monet, Manet, Degas, Cassatt, and Whistler. Our final attraction is the Roseland Cottage Arts & Crafts Festival – 39th year with 175 juried artists, music, and food.

October 21, 2021 - Krucker's Octoberfest

From a small cottage purchased by the Swiss immigrant Emil Krucker in 1929, Krucker's has grown from tents to permanent pavilions. The facility has remained in the family for four generations hosting parties and special events. Out Octoberfest begins upon arrival at 10:30am with scones, pancakes and apple cider. Lunch begins at noon and there is beer, wine and soft drinks all afternoon along with music, dancing, and bingo. If you want to just relax by the lake, that's ok. At 4pm we top off the day with a knockwurst sandwich.

December 4-5, 2021 – Christmas by the Sea (Newport, Rhode Island)

While Newport is known as the Summer playground for the wealthy, the charm of the holidays rivals the Summer. Our tour includes guided tours of two Gilded Age mansions decorated for Christmas. The Breakers was built between 1893 and 1895 as a summer residence for Cornelius Vanderbilt II. It has The 70-rooms with a gross area of 125,339 square feet and 62,482 square feet of living area on five floors. Each room will be decorated for the holidays. The Elms was the summer residence of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Julius Berwind of Philadelphia and New York. Mr. Berwind made his fortune in the coal industry. The home was modeled after a French chateau and built between 1898 and 1901. Out tour includes the "Spectacle of Lights" sound and light show on the grounds of the Breakers. Out second day highlight is a live performance of "A Christmas Carol" at the Trinity Repertory Theatre in Providence. Overnight at the Newport Beach Hotel & Suites.

December 11, 2021 – "A Christmas Carol" the musical

Broadway heavy hitters, Alan Menken (Disney's Beauty and the Beast, The Little Mermaid) and Lynn Ahrens (Ragtime, Once on This Island), breathe fantastic new life into the classic tale of Ebenezer Scrooge. This spectacular adaptation of Charles Dickens' most well-known story proved it's staying power with a decade-long run at the Theatre at Madison Square Garden. The production has moved to the White Plains Performing Arts Center. We have reserved a matinee performance to be followed by dinner at Mario's on Arthur Avenue in the Bronx. After dinner we visit The Bronx Christmas House, a one of a kind cross between Madame Tussaud's and the Vatican. One family, the Garabedians, decorate their home every year for nearly fifty years and it is a tradition for its neighbors and other Christmas lights enthusiasts.
