<u>March 17, 2022</u> - Troubles Less and Blessings More (St. Patrick's Day at Li Greci's)

Let the road rise up to meet you as we travel to Staten Island for "St. Patrick's Fest- from Ireland to America". Mike Byrne, perennial leader and international singing star, and his all star production celebrate St. Patrick's Day at LiGreci's Staaten Restaurant with a luncheon show to remember.

March 21 –24, 2022 - Spring in the Big Easy (New Orleans. LA)

While much of the country is either still deep in the throes of frigid weather or only just beginning to thaw, springtime in New Orleans comes a bit earlier. Guided tours of the Bryn Athyn Cathedral, and Frank Lloyd Wright's Beth Sholom Synagogue (an national landmark) have been added to our package. Four meals, including two lunches are included. Overnight accommodations are at the Lancaster Arts Hotel in downtown Lancaster.

<u>April 27, 2022</u> - Resorts World Catskills Casino

With its imposing Gothic Revival architecture and gorgeous perch overlooking the Hudson River, Lyndhurst Mansion in Tarrytown, NY is the dramatic backdrop for television shows, fashion and commercial shoots, and feature films. Our luncheon is at X20Xaviar's on the Hudson in Yonkers. The highly acclaimed Peter X. Kelly has operated some of the finest restaurants in New York State. X20Xaviar's sits on the water on the only turn of the century Victorian pier still in use on the Hudson River. After lunch we head to the Untermyer Gardens for a guided tour.

May 21, 2022 - The Good Earth Tour

Pearl S. Buck was the author of more than 85 books and winner of the Nobel and Pulitzer Prizes in literature. While Ms. Buck spent most of her life in China as a missionary, in the United States she became a prominent advocate of the rights of women and minority groups, and wrote widely on Chinese and Asian cultures, becoming particularly well known for her efforts on behalf of Asian and mixed-race adoption. The Pearl S. Buck House, a National Historic Landmark museum in Bucks County, PA, was the home of Pearl S. Buck and her family. Our tour of the home, the beautiful and iconic Bucks County stone farmhouse, contains a rich, intact collection from the extraordinary (the typewriter on which she wrote The Good Earth) to the ordinary (a closet full of board games her family played). Lunch is at the popular Cock N' Bull Restaurant in Peddler's Village. May is the Strawberry Festival month and live entertainment and strawberry-themed products abound at the shops at Peddler's Village.

Registration/Cancellation Policy
