June 3, 2023 - A Princely Town

While Princeton is known for its Ivy League University founded in 1746, Princeton is rich in history and beauty. For a few months in 1783 Princeton served as out nation's capital. The Grounds for Sculpture is a 42 acre sculpture park and museum. The audio tour enhances your visit to the fountains, orchards, and sculptures. Lunch is at La Mezzaluna in downtown Princeton. We conclude our tour with a wine tasting and visit to the farm store at Terhune Orchard.

June 29, 2923 - "The Sound of Music" at the Ivoryton Playhouse

You won't need to "climb every mountain" to see one of the most beloved musicals of all time. The Ivoryton Playhouse in Connecticut is the ideal theatre for this production. The outstanding cast promises to be a show to remember. David Pittsinger is renowned as a stage performer of the greatest distinction for his dramatic portrayals in the world's major opera houses. He received the nomination for the Helen Hayes Award for his performance as Emile de Becque in Rodgers & Hammerstein's South Pacific at the Kennedy Center. Patricia Schuman is a world-renowned mezzo-soprano. The luncheon is next door at The Blue Hound Cookery.

July 15, 2023 - Pride of the Hudson

We are pleased to repeat one of our favorite tours. We travel a short distance to Newburgh, New York for a luncheon overlooking the Hudson River at the Blu Pointe restaurant (formerly Torches on the Hudson). After lunch, we board the Pride of the Hudson for a 2 hour roundtrip narrated cruise down the Hudson from Newburgh to West Point. Our final destination is the Walkway Over the Hudson, where you can stroll across this beautiful pedestrian bridge.

July 31-August 2, 2023 - Downwind and to the East - Maine

Maine is not just known for its lobsters! The beautiful coastline, lighthouses, farms, and museums make Maine a perfect Summer tour. Our weekend tour includes a stop in Boston, Portland, Freeport, New Gloucester, and Kennebunkport. Highlights include the Portland Discovery sunset boat cruise, step-on guided tour passing the Old Port, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow's childhood home, Victoria Mansion, a stop at Portland Head Light (oldest lighthouse in Maine), LL Bean and the shops in Freeport, Pineland Farms and Gardens, browsing in the Old Port, and Dock Square with a view of the Bush Summer home.

August 12, 2023 - The Mermaid and Otter Creatures - Riverhead

Spend a relaxing day on the North Fork of Long Island. Our journey to Riverhead takes us to the Long Island Aquarium where we view the indoor and outdoor exhibits and scheduled shows. Lunch is next door at Jerry and the Mermaids. After lunch we return to the Aquarium and board the Atlantis Explorer for a tour conducted by Aquarium Educators down the Peconic River and into Flanders Bay.

August 23, 2023 - "A Beautiful Noise" on Broadway

The story of the legendary Neil Diamond comes to life on stage in an uplifting new musical featuring all his hit songs, including "Sweet Caroline," "America," and "Cracklin' Rosie." Registration/Cancellation Policy
