March 15, 2024 - The Irish Cabaret

A short drive to Hampton, NJ brings us to Hunterdon Hills Playhouse. Celebrate the St. Patrick's Day Cabaret with headliner Andy Cooney - "Irish America's Favorite Son". Andy's unique tenor voice has been heard in concert halls internationally, including hallmark venues ranging from Dublin's National Concert Hall to sold-out performances in New York's iconic Carnegie Hall. The admission includes a table-served entrée, dessert, coffee or hot tea.

Music is the universal language, and there is no better place to experience it than Nashville. Whether it be the Grand Ole Opry, or the HonkyTonks in downtown Nashville, there is something for everyone. Our four day fly-drive tour is filled with iconic venues—Ryman Auditorium, Opry House, Country Music Hall of Fame, Parthenon, Belle Meade Plantation, Opryland Hotel and more. Live performances are at the Grand Ole Opry and the Nashville Nightlife Dinner Theatre. Jet Blue Airlines is our carrier, and overnight accommodations are at the Embassy Suites. April 21, 2024 - "Beautiful" at the White Plains Performing Arts Center

If you missed it on Broadway, or loved it and want to see it again, "Beautiful" has a great story to go with the amazing music of Carole King. "Beautiful" tells the inspiring true story of King's remarkable rise to stardom, from being part of a hit song-writing team with her husband Gerry Goffin, to her relationship with fellow writers and best friends Cynthia Weil and Barry Mann, to becoming one of the most successful solo acts in popular music history. Lunch is at La Bocca across from the theatre.

May 4-7, 2024 - "Somewhere in Time (Mackinac Island, Michigan) WAITLIST ONLY

Mackinac Island has been one of the most requested destinations by our Travel Club members. The beauty of the unspoiled island on Lake Huron has no rival. What makes it special is no cars, and no chain hotels- just world-famous Mackinac Island Fudge, historic Fort Mackinac, unique shopping and diverse dining. You will enjoy the ferry from the mainland, a horse drawn carriage tour, and a luncheon at the famous Grand Hotel. We showcase the diversity of Michigan as we begin our tour in Holland Michigan where it is Tulip Time. Hundreds of thousands of visitors flock to Holland each year to see the tulips, the oldest operating windmill and a sampling of Dutch Culture. Enroute to Mackinac Island, we stop in Frankenmuth, a Bavarian village known for its food and the largest Christmas shop in the World with more than 50,00 ornaments. American Airlines is our carrier. Accommodations are at the Hampton Inn in Holland and the Bicycle Street Inn on Mackinac Island. Seven meals are included.

May 14, 2024 - "Hudson Valley and the Culinary Institute of America

Our day begins at Locust Grove - 200 acres of landscaped grounds set on a bluff overlooking the Hudson River. The Locust Grove Estate was purchased by painter and inventor Samuel Morse in 1847, using his profits from the invention of the telegraph. Our guide takes us through the Italianate Mansion. We have time to visit the museum and beautiful gardens before we depart for lunch. The Culinary Institute of America is the highlight of any tour. Lunch is prepared and served by the students of the CIA. After lunch, we visit the Adams Fairacres Farm. In 2019, the Adams Family celebrated the 100th anniversary of their farm. Now 200 acres, Fairacre Farms is a farmstand, country store, bakery, floral shop, gift shop and a garden and outdoor center.

May 22-23, 2024 - "Daniel 2024"

Sight & Sound theatres introduces its latest biblical production - "Daniel". From the fiery furnace to the infamous den of lions, Daniel is a spectacular theatrical experience. No theatre rivals the majesty of the Millennium Theatre in Strasburg, PA. Enjoy the spectacle of live theatre, magnificent sets and costumes and even live animals. This year we combine our visit to Amish Country with a day in Philadelphia. We visit the Liberty Bell before a brief highlight tour of some of Philadelphia's iconic sites. Lunch is on your own at the Reading Terminal Market where dozens of vendors entice you. Dinner is a buffet at the Shady Maple Restaurant. Overnight accommodations are at the Fairfield Inn by Marriott next to the Tanger Outlet Center. After breakfast, we have a short drive to the theatre for our early matinee performance. Following the performance, we visit the Kitchen Kettle Village. A lunch voucher will be provided.



Registration/Cancellation Policy
