June 8, 2024 - “Wonderland: Curious Nature”

Head down the rabbit hole as Wonderland: Curious Nature transforms the 250 acres through the sights, settings, and scents of the classic story of Alice's Adventures in Wonderland - and step into a botanical experience that grows curiously and curiously as you set off on your immersive journey. Lunch follows at Ann & Tony's on Arthur Avenue - a family owned Italian restaurant serving Classic Italian dishes for 5 generations since 1927. 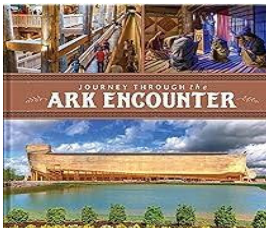
