### September 26, 2024 - "The Outsiders" on Broadway

Winner of 4 Tony Awards including Best Musical, this new musical is adapted from S.E. Hinton's seminal novel, and Francis Ford Coppola's iconic film. The tension between the Greasers and the SOCS (haves and have nots) is ultimately overshadowed by friendship, family, belonging and the feeling that there is still good in the world. Lunch is at Tony's di Napoli Times Square. Great music, choreography, and special effects all add up to an award winning show.

### Registration/Cancellation Policy
