March 19, 2025 - “Gypsy” on Broadway

The most awarded performer in Tony history. The greatest musical of all time. A star turn for the ages. Six-time Tony Award winner Audra McDonald plays the mother of all roles in a revelatory new production at the reopening of the legendary Majestic Theatre. Luncheon is at Tony’s di Napoli Times Square.

April 1, 2025 - “Swing!” at the Hunterdon Hills Playhouse in New Jersey

“Swing!” celebrates the music of the Swing era of jazz (1930s–1946), including many well-known tunes by artists like Duke Ellington, William "Count" Basie, Benny Goodman and others. It received a nomination for the 2000 Tony Award for Best Musical and other Tony awards. Swing! combines high energy dancing, singing and acrobatics. The show recreates the swing style of jazz, which used large bands, fixed musical arrangements and solo-driven improvisations. Lunch is served at the theatre.

April 21, 2025 - The Borough of Trees (Cherry Blossoms) and Neighborhoods

Have you been to Brooklyn lately? The Borough of Trees has evolved. One constant is the Brooklyn Botanic Gardens. Since 1911, millions of people have enjoyed this oasis. The cherry blossoms reveal themselves in the month of April. The Brooklyn Botanic Gardens also boasts of one of the most beautiful gardens - Japanese Hill-and-Pond Garden. Our tour director will visit some of the neighborhoods that have evolved such as Dumbo, Brooklyn Heights (including the Promenade) , and Brooklyn Bridge. Lunch is at Verde on Smith near Brooklyn Heights.

April 23-24, 2025 - “Noah”

May 12-15, 2025 - Pirates, Ponies, and Porpoises” - The outer Banks of North Carolina

From pristine beaches, lighthouses, and wild horses, the Outer Banks is one of the nation's most picturesque destinations. Our tour begins with a flight into Norfolk, VA. The Outer Banks is only an hour and a half from Norfolk. In fact, there is no excursion more than an hour and a half the entire four days! Highlights include a dolphin watch, wild horse tour, Wright Brothers Memorial, Elizabethan Gardens, Roanoke Island and the Carolina Aquarium. Accommodations are in Corolla. Seven meals are included.

May 17, 2025 - Picturesque Palisades and POEtry (Wave Hill and Poe Cottage)

One of the best kept secrets in New York City is Wave Hill in Riverdale. Once the home of Theodore Roosevelt, Mark Twain and Arturo Toscanini, Wave Hill is now 28 acres sitting high above the Hudson River with sweeping views and lots of open sky - an enchanting surprise for all of the senses. The gardens and woodland are acclaimed for plantsmanship, aesthetic sensibility and the human experience of nature. After our guided tour of Wave Hill, we head to Connaughton’s Steak House for lunch. Edgar Allan Poe Cottage in the Bronx is a New York City and State landmark, and on the National Registry of Historic Places. The Poe Cottage is the final home of Edgar Allan Poe. The home and museum conclude this special day.

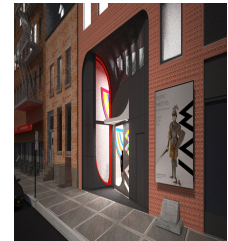

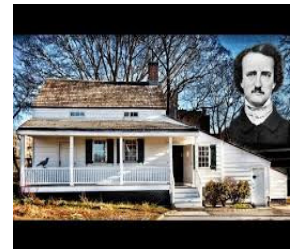

Pick-up Locations

Please note: not all pickups are scheduled for each trip. Contact us for more information.

Registration/Cancellation Policy

1. Day trips must be paid in full upon booking or within 10 days of booking with a check
