June 1, 2025 - "Sondheim's Old Friends"

Celebrate the life and work of the great Stephen Sondheim with an irresistible company headlined by none other than Tony Award® winners Bernadette Peters and Lea Salonga. Stephen Sondheim's Old Friends comes to Broadway from London's West End, where it earned a bevy of 5-star raves and was hailed by The Times as "unmissable musical theatre". Old Friends was devised and produced by Cameron Mackintosh (Les Misérables, Miss Saigon, The Phantom of the Opera and Cats) It won the Best Theatre Event award at the 2023 WhatsOnStage Awards in London . The intimate Samuel J. Friedman Theatre is the perfect venue for this limited engagement. Lunch is at Tony's di Napoli Times Square.

June 21, 2025 - "Leader of the Pack" at the Bucks County Playhouse

Never too old to rock n roll! Join us in the beautiful town of New Hope, Pennsylvania for a high spirited, foot-stomping romp. Before there was Beautiful, there was Leader of the Pack. Bop along to the songs you love in this Broadway musical celebrating the life and times of Ellie Greenwich, whose doo-wop sounds skyrocketed to the top of the '60s charts. Ellie's rise to fame is told via a virtual hit parade of her music including "Chapel of Love," "Da Doo Ron Ron," "Be My Baby," "River Deep, Mountain High", "And Then He Kissed Me," and, of course, the title song, "Leader of the Pack." Luncheon is at the Triumph Brewing Company in New Hope.

July 9, 2025 - River and Bay Cruise

Only one and a half hours from New York, we head to the Atlantic Highlands of New Jersey. All aboard the Navasink for a luncheon cruise along both the Shrewsbury River and Sandy Hook Bay. The scenic cruise aboard the paddle wheeler passes the Twin Lights and Sandy Hook Lighthouses. Enjoy a buffet of assorted sandwiches while we view the mansions, bungalows and lighthouses. After the cruise, we visit either the Sandy Hook Lighthouse or the unique Twin Lights.

July 23, 2025 - Summer Wind - Hoboken with Ol' Blue Eyes

When we think of Hoboken, NJ, we think of Frank Sinatra. The city pays homage to this musical and historical legend, as Hoboken was his birthplace and where he found his fame. Hoboken is decorated with all things Sinatra from restaurants to landmarks that feature all parts of his life. Our historian strings together sites, sounds, and stories about Frank Sinatra and his family. A highlight is the Sinatra Statue, unveiled in 2021 next to Sinatra Park. We even get to listen to some vinyl, view clips, and memorabilia at the Sinatra Lounge at the Hoboken Historical Museum. Lunch is at Leo's Grandevous, where Sinatra frequently dined. A chair is left at the bar for Frank, and there is a mural across from the restaurant commissioned by the restaurant. After lunch, we visit the Empty Sky Memorial (9/11 New Jersey Memorial) at Liberty State Park.

August 6, 2025 - "Newsies" at the Forestburgh Playhouse

NEWSIES is based on the real-life Newsboys' Strike of 1899. Children who sold newspapers on the streets were called "newsies". The New York newsies went up against two newspaper publishers, Joseph Pulitzer of The World and William Randolph Hearst of The Journal, to fight for fair wages. The musical premiered at the Paper Mill Playhouse in 2011 and made its Broadway debut in 2012, where it played for more than 1,000 performances winning two of its eight Tony nominations before touring. Luncheon is at the Tavern adjacent to the theatre. Forestburgh is in the Sullivan County Catskills near Monticello.

August 19-21, 2025 - On Golden Pond (New Hampshire)

Our New England Summer tradition takes us to New Hampshire. This year's New Hampshire tour combines both the Lakes and Mountain Regions of New Hampshire. Flashback to Henry Fonda and Katharine Hepburn spotting and calling to the loons on Golden Pond. It is actually Squam Lake, and our cruise is only a part of the New Hampshire itinerary. Attractions include the carousel and Arch at Bushnell Park, Castle in the Clouds, a scenic railroad excursion, the Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway, and the "Cottage"- ridiculous – potentially murderous – romantic comedy at the New London (NH) Barn Theatre. Accommodations are at the Margate Resort on Lake Winnipesaukee. Two dinners, 2 breakfasts, and 1 lunch are included.



Registration/Cancellation Policy
