**June 25, 2026 - “West Side Story” at the Papermill Playhouse**

The 1957 landmark Bernstein/Sondheim classic comes to the Paper Mill Playhouse in New Jersey. Papermill won a Tony Award for the best regional theatre in America. Many of their productions move to Broadway. Lunch is at Basilico down the street from the theatre.

**July 8-10, 2026 - “America’s Hometown and The Cape” - Plymouth and Cape Cod**

Did the Pilgrims first settle in Plymouth in 1620? That’s what we were taught. They actually landed in Cape Cod in November, 1620, and eventually settled in Plymouth (The American Hometown) in December, 1620. We combine both as we continue our America 250 series. Our tour visits the Plimoth Patuxet Museums (formerly Plimoth Plantation), Plymouth Rock and the Mayflower II in America’s Hometown”. We then head to “the Cape” for 2 nights. Our tour includes the ferry to Martha’s Vineyard, a guided tour of Oak Bluffs, Edgartown, and Vineyard Haven. For evening entertainment we hear the sounds of Rumors, a Fleetwood Mac tribute band at the Melody Tent. A ride along the National Seashore includes visits to The Truro Lighthouse, Marconi Station, and the Salt Pond Visitor's Center. Accommodations are at the Bayside Resort in West Yarmouth.

**July 15, 2026 - “1776” at the Ivoryton Playhouse**

We celebrate our nation’s history with the Tony Award winning musical “1776”. The Ivoryton Playhouse, where Katherine Hepburn began her career, is the perfect venue. Lunch is at the Scotch Plains Restaurant in Essex Connecticut.

**July 29 2026 - “Duel and Farewell” - Fraunces Tavern and the Financial District**

On America’s 250th birthday we visit iconic attractions, and an iconic restaurant from the Revolutionary War era. Fraunces Tavern, built in 1762, is famous for hosting George Washington’s Farewell Address, and the meal before the Hamilton-Burr duel. We begin with a tour of the museum above the Tavern. After lunch, our guide takes us to Trinity Church, and St. Paul’s Chapel where many of our founding fathers worshipped.

**August 13, 2026 - “Popcorn and Ports of Call” - Toms River, NJ**

All aboard the River Lady paddle wheeler for a sit-down luncheon cruise along the Toms and Barnegat Rivers. Following the cruise, we visit the Popcorn Park Animal Refuge. Popcorn Park Refuge, located in the scenic Pine Barrens of Ocean County, is now home to over 200 animals and birds, all provided spacious living quarters and assured a lifetime of good care. Popcorn Park became a permanent home to exotics, wildlife, farm animals, and birds who suffered abandonment, cruelty, injury, illness, handicap, exploitation, old age, inappropriate ownership, or who could not be safely returned to the wild.

**August 27, 2026 - The Rose and the Thorn - Old Saybrook and West Hartford CT**

Just a short drive takes us to Katharine Hepburn Country in Old Saybrook. The Katharine Hepburn Museum offers a delightful insight into her life. It offers an authentic view of the cultural and historical impact of Miss Hepburn and her family through letters, photos, home movies, costumes, personal wardrobe items, and other memorabilia. Next, we head to West Hartford and the Helen S. Kaman Rose Garden at Elizabeth Park. The rose garden is the oldest, and third largest rose garden in the United States, with 212 rose beds, 150 unique varieties, and 75 rose arches. Lunch is at the Red Fox Restaurant. After our self-guided visit, we head down the road for a wine tasting at the Crystal Ridge Winery - a 250 acre, family-owned vineyard.

**September 23-26, 2026 - “Second City Meets the Mother Road” - Chicago and Route 66**

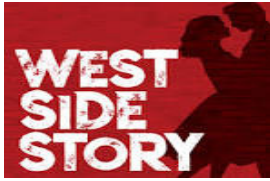
We fly into Chicago via American Airlines. , our hub for this tour. The architecture, canals, rivers, and lake Michigan make Chicago one of the most beautiful cities in America. Celebrate 100 years of road tripping along Route 66 where we flashback to the neon signs, murals, roadside cafes, and Abraham Lincoln history. Day trips from Chicago take us to Frank Lloyd Wright’s home and studio, Ernest Hemingway’s birthplace, the Baha’i House of Worship, the Oak Park Conservatory, and the Skokie Sculpture Park. We take an architecture boat cruise on the Chicago River, visit the Riverwalk, Millennium Park, the Chicago Cultural Center, and of course Wrigley field- home of the “cubbies”. Overnight accommodations are at the Riu Plaza. Eight meals are included.
