



September 9, 2026 - "The South Fork"

For a delightful "Indian Summer" day, experience our unique itinerary. We take our motorcoach aboard two small ferries from Greenport to Shelter Island, and then from Shelter Island to Sag Harbor. We visit the Sag Harbor Historical Museum and a wine tasting at Duck Walk Vineyards in Water Mill. Lunch is at Jerry and the Mermaid in Riverhead.

September 23, 2026 - "Schmigadoon" on Broadway (SOLD OUT)

Receiving the Tony award for best musical, "Schmigadoon" will delight you and make you feel good! Based on the television series, the hilarious musical parodies classic Broadway musicals. Lunch is at Tony's di Napoli Times Square.

October 3, 2026 - "The Small Miracle"- Winery Train

All aboard the Winery Train (Delaware River Railroad) in Phillipsburg, New Jersey. Travel along the Delaware River to the town of Riegelsville, New Jersey. We disembark and take the shuttle up the hill to Villa Milagro (home of miracles) Vineyards overlooking two rivers and two states. Enjoy a wine-making tour, a tasting, and hors d'oeuvres before taking the railroad back. A late lunch at Chelsea's Restaurant is included after the Winery Train.

October 14-15, 2026 - "Water Colors" - leaf peeping in Upstate New York

The Hudson Valley offers some of the most spectacular Fall foliage, and a wide variety of attractions. Our overnight tour includes a luncheon overlooking the Hudson River at Mariner's Harbor in Kingston, a scenic cruise aboard the Rip Van Winkle, a luncheon at The Tavern at Beekman Arms in Rhinebeck (the oldest inn in America), a guided tour of Clermont (Livingston family estate), a walk across the Hudson, and a tasting at Millbrook Vineyards. Dinner is at Coppola's in Hyde Park. Accommodations are at the Hyatt Place Poughkeepsie.

November 10, 2026 - "Calling All Divas"

We return to LiGreci's Staaten Restaurant in Staten Island for a special show. Lisa Sherman (Broadway, the Rockettes, and numerous concerts) headlines a tribute to generations (from the '40's to the present) of female singers (Fannie Brice, Barbara Streisand, Bette Midler, Carol King, Carly Simon, Cass Elliott, and Laura Nero). Lisa's band and singers are joined by a comedian. A full, sit-down luncheon is served with beer and wine.

December 4-6, 2026 - "Holidays on the Peninsula"

Our annual holiday tour heads down the east coast to the Delmarva Peninsula (Delaware, Maryland and Virginia). The first stop is the German Christmas Market and Festival of Trees at Love Park in Philadelphia. Our next stop is our most requested attraction - Longwood Gardens. The holiday display in the new atrium, and the illuminated grounds, are always a highlight. The second day is spent at Chincoteague Island, where our tour guide takes us for a closeup look at the wild ponies and other natural highlights. In the evening, we visit the lights and attractions at Winterfest in Ocean City. Our final day takes us to Odessa where the historic homes reflect how the people of that time celebrated the holidays. Accommodations are at the Hilton Suites Oceanfront hotel in Ocean City, Maryland.

December 12, 2026 - "Annie's 50th Anniversary"

Leapin' Lizards! The musical that stole America's heart comes home to celebrate its 50th Anniversary on the stage where it all began. The heartwarming musical returns to the intimate Goodspeed Opera House in East Haddam, Connecticut where it previewed before its Broadway run. The new production will put you in the holiday spirit. Lunch is at the Scotch Plains Tavern in Essex.

April 21-22, 2027 - "Jonah" - at the Sight & Sound Theatre

Just when you thought we could not top last year's Sight & Sound tour, we met the challenge. Next April, we head to Lancaster for the revival of "Jonah". This audience favorite first premiered on March 10, 2012, at the Millennium Theatre in Lancaster. This year's tour pairs "My Fair Lady" at the Fulton theater in downtown Lancaster. The Fulton Theatre is considered America's oldest continuously operating theatre. Built in 1852 on the site of an infamous 18th-century jail, it has evolved from a community meeting hall to a premier regional performing arts venue, earning National Historic Landmark status in 1969. A pre-theater dinner will be at Miller's Smorgasbord. Our matinee performance of "Jonah", on the second day, is followed by a visit to Kitchen Kettle Village. Overnight accommodation are at the Inn at Leola Village.

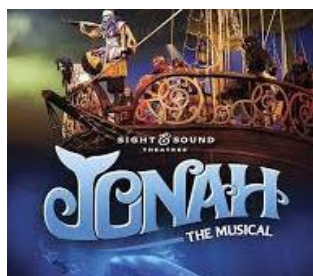

Pick-up Locations

We have several standard pick-up locations, based on registration, listed below.

Registration/Cancellation Policy

1. Day trips must be paid in full upon booking or within 10 days of booking with a check
2. Overnight tours require a \$100 per person deposit the day of booking or 1 week by check
3. Thirty days prior to departure - full refund unless stated otherwise
4. Fourteen days prior to departure - balance after out of pocket expenses
